




The blessing of mercy: bible perspectives and ecological challenges

A guide for Catholics in this Year of Mercy. The author is an Australian Sister of Mercy.




Man's search for meaning

The author, a Holocaust survivor, found meaning in work, love and courage.




The gospels: God with us

Information about the Gospels and their authors for students in years 5-8.




Celebrations of the world: big book

Celebrates differences.




Liturgy and the new evangelization: practicing the art of self-giving love






Preferential option for the family : one hundred questions and answers relating to the Synod

This book was written prior to the Synod on the Family in an effort to clear up confusion over the Church's teaching on marriage and the family.




The 2015 Synod : the crucial questions: divorce and homosexuality

Bishop Geoffrey Robinson asserts that the church must find 'room to move' if pastoral solutions are to be found.




Rebuilding youth ministry: ten practical strategies for Catholic parishes

Advises Catholic leaders on how to overcome complacency and underestimating the value of the youth in the parish.




Purgatory : the two Catholic views of purgatory based on Catholic teaching and revelations of saintly souls

Fr. Frederick Faber explains the two Catholic views of Purgatory – 'almost like Hell' or 'a place of peace and joy'.




A marginal Jew: rethinking the historical Jesus. Vol 4: law and love.

Deals with the teachings of Jesus on topics such as divorce, oaths, the Sabbath and purity rules.




Teilhard de Chardin, The divine milieu explained : a spirituality for the 21st century

Spiritual methods that integrate science and faith.




Applied ethics in a world church: the Padua conference

The author builds an argument for a 'sense for the spiritual dimension'.




