




Tell me about the Catholic faith: from the Bible to the sacraments.

Contents include: The Bible, The Christian Faithful, and The Beliefs and Sacraments.




Convictions: how I learned what matters most

For his seventieth birthday, Marcus Borg wrote this manifesto on how to be a follower of Jesus today.




The art of life : monastic wisdom for every day

Joan Chittister helps us to find and become “the best of ourselves” through these daily reflections.




A chronology of world Christianity

Contents: Advent and Christmas, Lent, Easter to Pentecost, Festivals, and Ordinary Time.








John Henry Newman: a cardinal for our times

The author uses positive emotions to help deal with a diagnosis of mesothelioma.




The great divorce : a dream (Fiction)

A moral fable in which an Englishman learns the consequences of his actions by travelling through heaven and hell.




The gospels

Set in the 12th century. Brother Cadfael is a herbalist and monk who solves the inevitable murder.




The future of Islam





Mr Sarra was the first Aboriginal principal of Cherbourg State School. In six years he transformed the school into a national success story.




