



A collection of essays from acclaimed theologian, Robert Barron.





Investigates the milestones, the contributions the Church has made, the challenges it has faced and continues to face.






Crimes of the father

This Bible big book is beautifully illustrated and easy to read aloud because the text is reproduced on the back cover.




This is Gail: life with and after Chris O'Brien

Tells the story of surgeon Chris O'Brien's struggle with brain cancer and the effects on his family.







Follows the campaign and canonisation of St Mary MacKillop.




