

Authorised Officers include:

People from the following professional and occupational groups:

- an accountant – member of a recognised professional accounting body or a Registered Tax Agent
- Australian legal practitioner authorised to take and receive any affidavit
- the NSW Registrar-General
- a Deputy Registrar-General
- a Commissioner for Affidavits, Declarations or Oaths
- a bail justice or sheriff
- a police officer
- a postal manager
- a principal of an Australian secondary college, high school or primary school
- a medical practitioner
- a Justice of the Peace (with a registration number in the State in which they are registered)
- Notary public
- a minister of religion

Other authorising officers are:

- Catholic School Office staff
- other person by law authorised to administer an oath.
