







Rituals for life, love & loss
The author has created simple ceremonies for all people - regardless of their faith. The book is presented in three parts: Celebrations, Changes, and Letting Go.




A fresh look at confession: why it really is good for the soul

The author provides a deeper understanding of the life of Jesus - as it is presented in the gospels.












