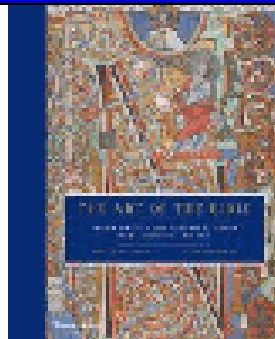

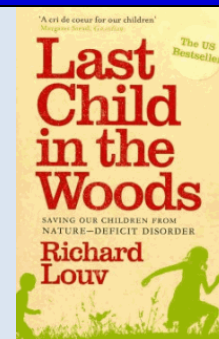

This book encourages positive behaviour in children.



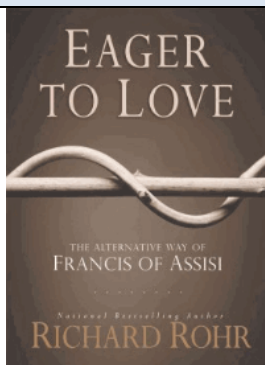
**The art of the Bible: illuminated manuscripts from the medieval world (Reference)**

Artistic interpretations of the Bible spanning 1000 years.



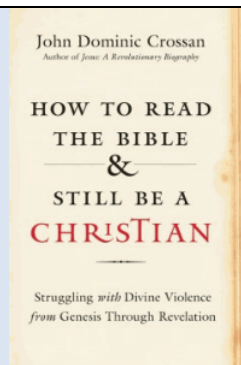
**Last child in the woods: saving our children from nature-deficit disorder**

The author believes that you can improve the life of a child by “opening the door to nature”.



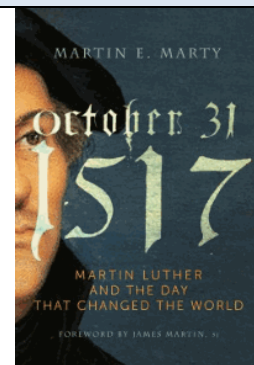
**Eager to love: the alternative way of Francis of Assisi**

Richard Rohr, a Franciscan friar, helps us understand the tradition first practiced by St Francis.













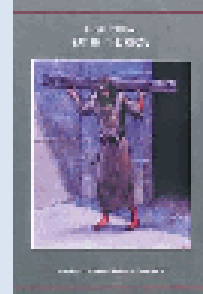
The Arch series has been popular for decades.

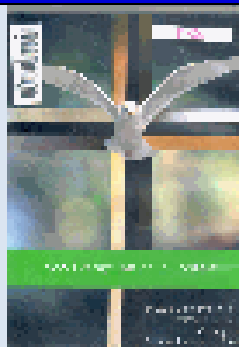
