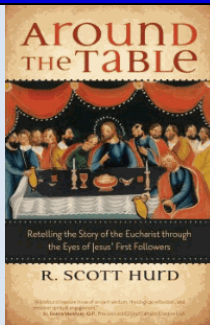

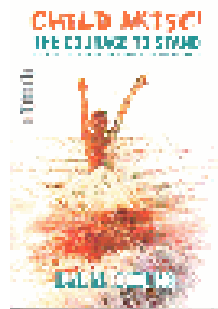

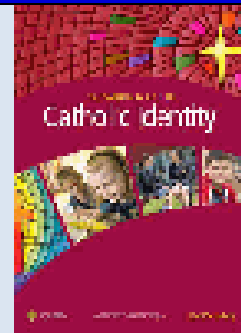
**Retelling the story of the Eucharist through the eyes of Jesus' first followers**

Scott Hurd tells the stories of fourteen biblical characters who were close to Jesus.



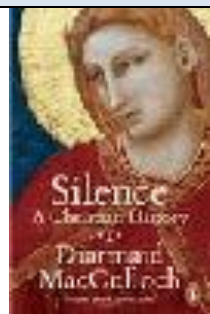
**Child arise! : the courage to stand: a spiritual handbook for survivors of sexual abuse**

A practical handbook that promotes healing by taking survivors on a guided journey through the Scriptures.



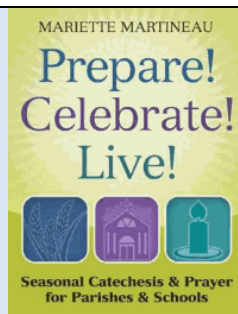
**Educator's guide to Catholic identity**

This is a practical guide for Catholic school leadership teams.

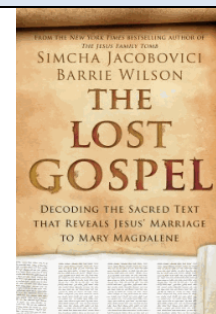


**Silence : a Christian history**

Deals with prayer and contemplation and also the silence surrounding the abuse by clergy.

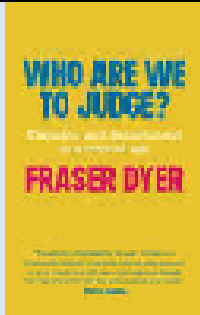


**Prepare! celebrate! live! seasonal catechesis and prayer for parishes and schools**  
Provides information and guidelines for prayer throughout the Church year.



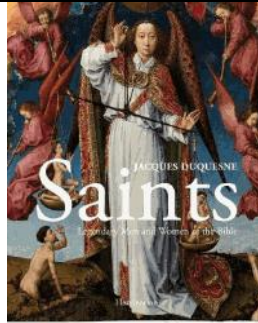
**The lost Gospel : decoding the ancient text that reveals Jesus' marriage to Mary the Magdalene**

An English translation of a document that is almost 1500 years old.



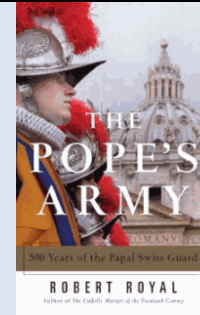
**Who are we to judge? : empathy and discernment in a critical age**

The author offers practical suggestions on how to move away from judgementalism and towards loving thy neighbor.



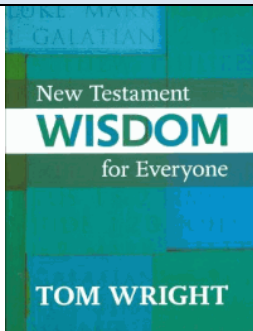
**Saints : men and women of exceptional faith**

A comprehensive study of sainthood beginning at its origins.



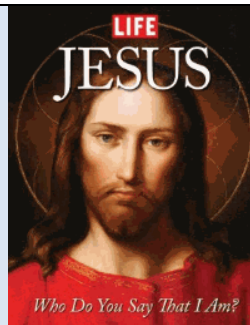
**The Pope's army : 500 years of the Papal Swiss Guard**

Inspiration for the meditations in this book is drawn from the 'New Testament for Everyone' series.



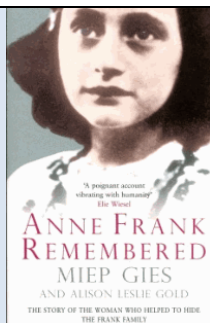
**Jesus: who do you say I am?**

The story of Jesus accompanied by paintings of landscapes and landmarks of the areas in which He lived and preached.



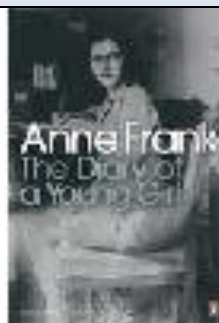
**Wisdom in leadership : the how and why of leading the people you serve**

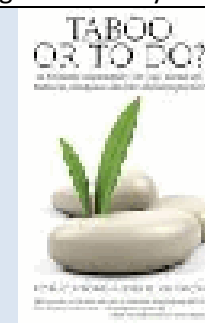
**Anne Frank remembered : the story of the woman who helped to hide the Frank family**
