50 % credit + 2 units = New Qualifications

If you are a BBI graduate or have completed a Graduate Certificate in Theology from another tertiary institution, you are eligible to receive 50 % credit when you enrol in a further qualification with BBI such as the Graduate Certificate in Leadership & Theology which would equip you with the skills to take up leadership positions in Catholic schools.

For example, if you previously completed a Graduate Certificate in Theology with us or with another tertiary institution, then you only need to complete two more units or subjects to graduate with a Graduate Certificate in Leadership & Theology. This could be completed part-time in one year.

4-year credit rule extended to 10 years

The general rule in relation to the application for credit into postgraduate study at most tertiary institutions across Australia is based on having completed studies within the past four years.

In response to sector needs, **BBI has introduced a 10-year rule for recognition of prior study**, which may articulate into BBI's courses, subject to our credit and RPL policy: goo.gl/5OH0Kn. Those, whose study period may fall outside the 10-year rule, will be considered on a case by case basis.

If you have completed a **Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma or Masters in Theology/Religious Education/Leadership**, anytime between 2007 and 2017, at any Australian tertiary institution, you may be eligible to receive up to 50 % credit, reducing the total number of units which must be completed to attain the qualification

Recognition of previous qualifications

All of BBI's courses are nested, meaning that they build on one another, ensuring that students receive credit for courses previously accomplished. Students who have completed relevant study elsewhere may also be eligible for recognition of this prior learning, which would reduce the overall length of their course with BBI.
