##### PLEASE READ CONDITIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE APPLYING

- ◆ Applicants' HSC results will be taken into consideration: applicants must send their HSC results to Narelle Cross, Employee Services at the CSO before **22 December 2017** to be considered.
- ◆ Applicants must meet the Australian Tertiary Admission Requirements for University.
- ◆ Applicants must be Catholics.
- ◆ Teachers in primary schools must have Mathematics in their courses of study.
- ◆ Students who enter teacher training will be eligible to apply for one of the five scholarships on offer.
- ◆ By participating in this scholarship program students are contributing to the development of the quality of the teaching profession in the Diocese of Maitland-Newcastle, and enhancing their own professional career.
- ◆ Continuation in the program will be dependent upon continuing enrolment and the maintenance of suitable academic and professional standards.
- ◆ The program will not extend beyond a four (4) year duration.
